
Strategic Planning for Technical work Program



Working arrangements

 - Crediting working group (expanding the scope of the current offset working group);
 - MRV working group; and
 - Baseline working group.
- Engage via email and meet virtually. Face-to-face meetings only where beneficial for the work-stream's activities.
- The PA is encouraged to nominate the most relevant representatives to participate in the working groups.

 - Will be presented to the PA for its endorsement.
- PMR website restructure, update, and improved accessibility
- Knowledge products formerly published and disseminated through the World Bank's Open Knowledge Repository (OKR)
- Translation to other languages where useful
- Regular newsletter and notifications via various networks
- Carbon Expo and other conferences



Budget for FY16
